Egyptian myth a local Theban god, having a ram's head and symbolizing life and fertility, identified by the Egyptians with the national deity Amen-Ra

Amun, also spelled Amon, Amoun, Amen, was a god in Egyptian and Berber mythology who in the form of Amun-Ra became the focus of the most complex system of theology in Ancient Egypt.

Amen-Ra

Egyptian sun god; supreme god of the universe in whom Amen and Ra were merged; principal deity during Theban supremacy
