Some Christians say Psalms:111:9 condemns it.

King James Bible

Psalms:111:9: He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant for ever: holy and reverend is his name

NIV Bible

Psalms:111:9: He provided redemption for his people; he ordained his covenant forever— holy and awesome is his name.

Hebrew Bible

Psalms:111:9: He hath sent redemption unto His people; He hath commanded His covenant for ever; Holy and awful is His name.

Its normal for the first letter of a persons name be capitalized. Holy and reverend is not capitalized in the KJB.

There is no debate here. No need to judge others by their titles.

Does it matter if a Christians have Icons in their Churches and homes.

These icons can be pictures and statues and maybe other objects.

Most of us have pictures in our homes and/or wallets of family members.

Most churches have a cross in it (is this a type of Icon).

Many women and some men wear a necklaces with some type of Christian symbol.

- 6) Can we confirm he was crucified on a stake or cross? What difference does it make. He was Gods lamb to die for our sins.
- 7) What happened between the age of 12 to 30. What did he do? Can any of this be confirmed? Do you think anyone would have followed a 12 year old?

Why debate on the items above? Will it send you to hell or give you a free pass to heaven? A contentious person will exhibit a perverse and wearisome tendency to quarrels and disputes.

Does it say anywhere in the Bible that if we eat any type of meat we want we will go to Hell and into the lake of fire?

Gen:1:27: So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Gen:1:29: And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat.

Gen:1:30: And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.

Gen:9:3: Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things. There is no debate here. Who or what is behind starting debates about food we can eat or not to eat?

Read all of Leviticus

The following verses inform the Jewish people of animals they are not to eat.

Lev. 11:3; Deut. 14:6

11:9; Deut. 14:9

Lev. 11:13-19; Deut. 14:11-18

Lev. 11:22

Lev. 11:29-30, 42-43

Some of the Forbidden animals not to eat.

Camel, rock badger, the hare and the pig, bear meat, horses or horse family, rabbits Birds of prey or scavengers.

Rodents, reptiles, amphibians, and insects (but all of them).

Any product derived from the forbidden animals, such as their milk, eggs, fat, or organs, also cannot be eaten.

Shellfish such as lobsters, oysters, shrimp, clams and crabs.

Acts 11: 7-10

And I heard a voice saying unto me, Arise, Peter; slay and eat.

But I said, Not so, Lord: for nothing common or unclean hath at any time entered into my mouth. But the voice answered me again from heaven, What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common. And this was done three times: and all were drawn up again into heaven.
