

GODS people having Tattoos

Lev. 19:28 says, Ye shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor print any marks upon you: I am Jehovah.

First of all thia was said to the Jews.

It must be understood that the gentiles were getting their skin cut and marked in their cult religions.

Today many tattoos have pictures representing the evil one and pictures of death and pain. This is direct rebellion against GOD. Having tattoos of followers and other objects is breaking the **4th Commandment** (Thou shalt not make unto thee a graven image, nor any likeness *of any thing* that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.)

So why have them on your body

Young people have a tendency to practice rebellion and deviancy and get a tattoo to show their rebellion.

1Sam. 15:23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as idolatry and teraphim. Because thou hast rejected the word of Jehovah, he hath also rejected thee from being king.

It is possible to get Hepatitis C and AIDS and infections while getting a tattoo if the instruments have not been correctly cleaned before being used. There are only a few states that have laws regulating tattoo parlors. How can you be sure their equipment is clean.

I have read that there are Christians getting tattoos and claim that when the rider on the horse will have a tattoo on his thigh as stated in Revelation chapter 19:11-16. He will have a tattoo on his thigh therefore they can have a tattoo. Are they correct in their understanding of this verse?

Is it correct to assume that the rider on the horse did not have his legs covered. Will his legs be uncovered in Revelation 19: verse 16?
