The words that Jesus said will be in red. My comments will be in blue.

Matt 7:21-23 (KJV) ²¹ Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. ²² Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? ²³ And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Will you hear the words I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity?

Many Christian churches teach that Jesus was GOD in the flesh. The following is who Jesus said he was. Jesus said it, and I believe it. Who do you believe mankind, or Jesus, or John 1:1-14

Below is who Jesus say he was?

Matt 16:13-20 (KJV)

¹³ When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, **Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?** ¹⁴ And they said, Some say *that thou art* John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. ¹⁵ He saith unto them, **But whom say ye that I am?** ¹⁶ And Simon Peter answered and said, **Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.** ¹⁷ And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed *it* unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven. ¹⁸ And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. ¹⁹ And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. ²⁰ **Then charged he his disciples that they should tell no man that he was Jesus the Christ.**

Comment: That is why Peter denied three times to knowing Jesus.

John 14:28 (KJV)

²⁸ **Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come *again* unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I.**

John 8:57-58 (KJV)

⁵⁷ Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? ⁵⁸ Jesus said unto them, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.**

Comment: (Most Christians say John 8:58 is proof that Jesus was GOD in the flesh. Notice that in Ex 3:14 the I AM is capitalized)

In the New Testament John 8:58 **I am** is not capitalized in the NIV and the Complete Jewish Bible, and the Bible Explorer software. I looked in five of my King James Bibles and only one shows a capitalized **I AM**. The other four are I am (not capitalized). Look in different Bibles for yourself and you will see the truth.

I AM = GOD's name Ex. 3:14

I am = is not the same as in Ex 3:14)

GOD told Moses to tell the people his name was _____?

Ex 3:13-15 (KJV) King James Bible

13 And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them?

14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. 15 And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The Lord God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

Ex 3:14 JPS Hebrew-English Tanakh

14 And God said to Moses, "Ehyeh-Asher-Ehyeh". He continued, "Thus yiu say to the Israelites, 'Ehyeh sent me to you."

Ex 3:14 Complete Jewish Bible translated by David H. Stern

14 And God said to Moses, "Ehyeh Asher Ehyeh" [I am/will be what I am/will be], and added, Here is what to say to to the people of Isra'el: 'Ehyeh [I Am or I Will Be] has sent me to you."

Ex 3:14 The Stone Edition - Tanach

14 Hashem answered Moses, "I shall Be As I shall Be." And he said, So shall you say to the children Israel, 'I shall Be has sent me to you."

In English Bibles I have found the following in verse EX. 3:14

I AM THAT I AM - In Hebrew its EHYEH Asher EHYEH

I AM Who I AM - In Hebrew its EHYEH Asher EHYEH

I will be who I will be - In Hebrew its EHYEH Asher EHYEH

I shall Be As I Shall Be - In Hebrew its EHYEH Asher EHYEH

I will exist because I will exist - In Hebrew its EHYEH Asher EHYEH

I AM that which exist - In Hebrew its EHYEH Asher EHYEH

Comment: In the Hebrew language in the Old Testament GOD told Moses to tell the people that EHYEH sent him unto you. After this what name did the people say the name of their GOD was? We can pray to EHYEH. EHYEH was translated to I AM in English. My name is the same in ever language. Why, and who changed the name of GOD to I AM?

John 8:54-59

54 Jesus answered, **If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God: 55 Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying. 56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. 57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? 58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was EHYEH. 59 Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.**

Comment: Who was speaking in John 8:54-59? Was GOD speaking though Jesus, or was Jesus speaking of himself. Read it out loud to yourself and let your ears hear your words.

Mark 14:61-62 (KJV) ⁶¹ But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed? ⁶² And Jesus said, **I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.**

John 4:25-26 (KJV)

²⁵ The woman saith unto him, I know that Messiah cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. ²⁶ Jesus saith unto her, **I that speak unto thee am he.**

John 7:28-29 (KJV)

²⁸ Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, **Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and I am not come of myself, but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not.** ²⁹ **But I know him: for I am from him, and he hath sent me.**

John 8:42-45 (KJV)

⁴² Jesus said unto them, **If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.** ⁴³ Why do ye not understand my speech? *even* because ye cannot hear my word. ⁴⁴ Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. ⁴⁵ And because I tell *you* the truth, ye believe me not.

John 8:16-19 (KJV)

¹⁶ And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me. ¹⁷ It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true. ¹⁸ I am one that bear witness of myself, and **the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.** ¹⁹ Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.

John 12:44-50 (KJV)

⁴⁴ Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me. ⁴⁵ And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me. ⁴⁶ I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness. ⁴⁷ And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. ⁴⁸ He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. ⁴⁹ **For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a**

commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. ⁵⁰ And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.

John 14:9-11 (KJV)

⁹ Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father? ¹⁰ Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. ¹¹ Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

COMMENT: (Christians show this statement as another reason to say Jesus was GOD in the flesh. Does verse 20 below make all believers gods?)

John 14:15-27 (KJV)

¹⁵ If ye love me, keep my commandments. ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; ¹⁷ *Even* the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. ¹⁸ I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. ¹⁹ Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also. ²⁰ At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

Question: does verse 20 make us gods?

²¹ He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. ²² Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? ²³ Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. ²⁴ He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me. ²⁵ These things have I spoken unto you, being *yet* present with you. ²⁶ But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. ²⁷ Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Mark 9:37 (KJV)

³⁷ Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me.

Matthew 3: 16-17

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the

heavens were opened unto him, and he saw **the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.**

Read all of John 17: Who was Jesus paying to?

While Jesus was on the cross he asked GOD a question.

Matt 27:46 (KJV) ⁴⁶ And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, **Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?** that is to say, **My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?**

John 10:22-38 (KJV)

²² And it was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter. ²³ And Jesus walked in the temple in Solomon's porch. ²⁴ Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly. ²⁵ Jesus answered them, **I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me.** ²⁶ But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you. ²⁷ My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: ²⁸ And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand. ²⁹ My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand. ³⁰ **I and my Father are one.** ³¹ Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him. ³² Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me? ³³ The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God. ³⁴ Jesus answered them, **Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?** ³⁵ If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken; ³⁶ Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God? ³⁷ If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. ³⁸ But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father *is* in me, and I in him.

John 8:28-30 (KJV)

²⁸ Then said Jesus unto them, **When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am *he*, and *that* I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.** ²⁹ And he that sent me is with me: **the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.** ³⁰ As he spake these words, many believed on him.

John 7:28-29 (KJV) ²⁸ Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and I am not come of myself, but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not. ²⁹ But I know him: for I am from him, and he hath sent me.

Matt 19:16-22 (KJV)

¹⁶ And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? ¹⁷ And he said unto him, *Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.* ¹⁸ He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, ¹⁹ Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. ²⁰ The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet? ²¹ Jesus said unto him, *If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me.* ²² But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.

Num 23:19 (KJV)

19 God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

Is there any double talk in who Jesus said he was?

Has the Holy Spirit shown you the truth?

Do you believe the truth?

Do you want to believe the truth?

Do you teach the truth?

John 8:31-32 (KJV)

³¹ Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, *If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;* ³² *And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free*
